Your Safety

- In order to keep all workshop users as safe as possible, please follow these simple guidelines.
- Please don't attend Seacourt Print Workshop if you are experiencing any symptoms that may be related to Covid-19.
- We will reduce the numbers of people able to attend the studio at one time. It is therefore important that you only visit if you have pre-booked your attendance.
- The tutor will run through our studio safety measures when you arrive, please adhere to these measures closely and ask questions if anything is unclear.
- Social distancing of 2 metres is compulsory in the studio. Please be mindful of the health and comfort of other studio users.
- Face coverings are optional but please wear one if you will feel more comfortable and bring your own apron to wear in the studio (or clothes that you don't mind getting inky). Our tutors and technicians will be wearing visors and will change their apron daily.
- We will ask you to clean your hands, on entry and exit and regularly while you are here.
- We will maintain a rigorous and regular cleaning regime in the studio. Please help us by keeping your workstation clean.
- Please provide full contact details as requested when booking so that we can trace you if necessary.

What to Bring

Please bring with you any ideas, sketchbooks or images that you may like to work from. These can be used as a starting point for the creative process. All the equipment and materials necessary for your course are provided at the workshop, however having your own craft knife and basic drawing kit would also be useful. You are welcome to bring any additional tools that might be relevant to your course.

What to wear	<p>We recommend that you wear clothes you won't mind getting inky and an apron.</p> <p>We have denim Seacourt Print Workshop branded printmaking aprons available for purchase in the workshop at £20.</p>
Refreshments	<p>We are sorry that we can't offer refreshments or space to eat in the studio at present. Please bring some bottled water and a travel mug with a beverage of your choice.</p> <p>Lunch, if required, can be obtained from a good selection of local shops.</p>
Parking & Access to Industrial Park	<p>There is ample parking outside Seacourt.</p> <p>We recommend you enter through the gate beside ART & FRAMING.</p> <p>On evenings and weekends the gate may be closed but the tutor is in the building. We endeavour to keep the gates to the industrial park open but sometimes it is closed by other residents.</p> <p>If you find you need the gates to be opened please mobile phone the number provided to you ahead of the session.</p>
