What to Bring	<p>Please bring with you any ideas, sketchbooks or images that you may like to work from. These can be used as a starting point for the creative process. All the equipment and materials necessary for your course are provided at the workshop, however having your own craft knife and basic drawing kit would also be useful. You are welcome to bring any additional tools that might be relevant to your course. A notebook and pen would also be advised to jot down every nugget of information for your own reference, at a later date.</p> <p>For Screen printing or Photo Intaglio classes – we will produce high contrast black & white photocopies on acetate or drawings on acetate. What to wear	<p>We recommend that you wear clothes you won't mind getting inky and an apron.</p> <p>We have Seacourt Print Workshop branded printmaking aprons available for purchase in the workshop at £21.</p>
Refreshments	<p>We'll provide tea and coffee but we recommend you bring some bottled water.</p> <p>Lunch, if required, can be obtained from a good selection of local shops.</p>
